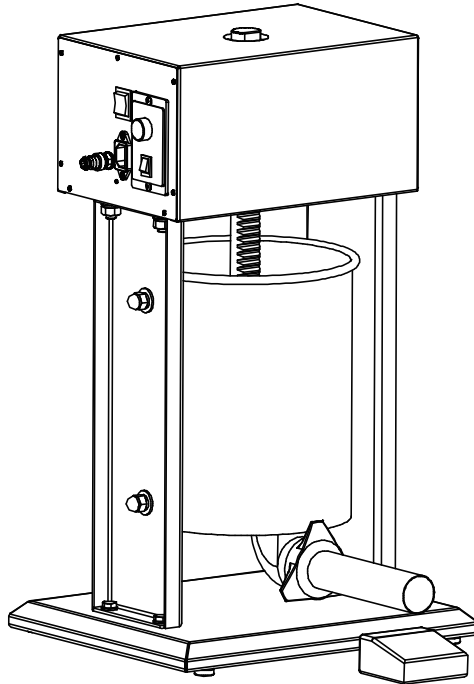

Thank you for using this product. In order to make sure that you can operate the machine properly, please read this manual carefully before use. Please be sure to read the SAFETY PRECAUTIONS in this page to ensure your safe use.

1. Please unplug the power of the machine before cleaning, assembling or disassembling.
2. Do not place the product in the reach of children. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
3. This product is not recommended for children or persons with physical, sensory and intellectual disabilities, unless they have gotten the supervision and instruction of how to use the product properly.
4. Do not put hands into the machine during.
5. Do not unplug the machine until it stops running.
6. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced with a special power cord or component provided by the manufacturer.
7. Electric Shock Danger! Non-professional personnel are forbidden to repair the products, otherwise it may result in electrical shock. When a malfunction occurs, it should be repaired by qualified service personnel.
8. WARNING! It is strictly prohibited to put the main body into the water to clean. Only can be scrubbed with wet towel. The machine must be fully cooled before cleaning.
9. Please check that the specified supply voltage in the product is consistent with the supply voltage (AC only).
10. Avoid damage to the power cord. Do not squeeze, bend or friction it, keep it away from heat sources and open fires. The power cord should not touch the blade.
11. Power cord should be laid flat. Do not pull the power cord and make the product fall down, which may cause damage.
12. Do not use the product on wet ground. Do not touch the product or power cord plug with wet hands.
13. Do not disassemble the product at will. Do not allow things to enter or insert into the product, which may cause damage.

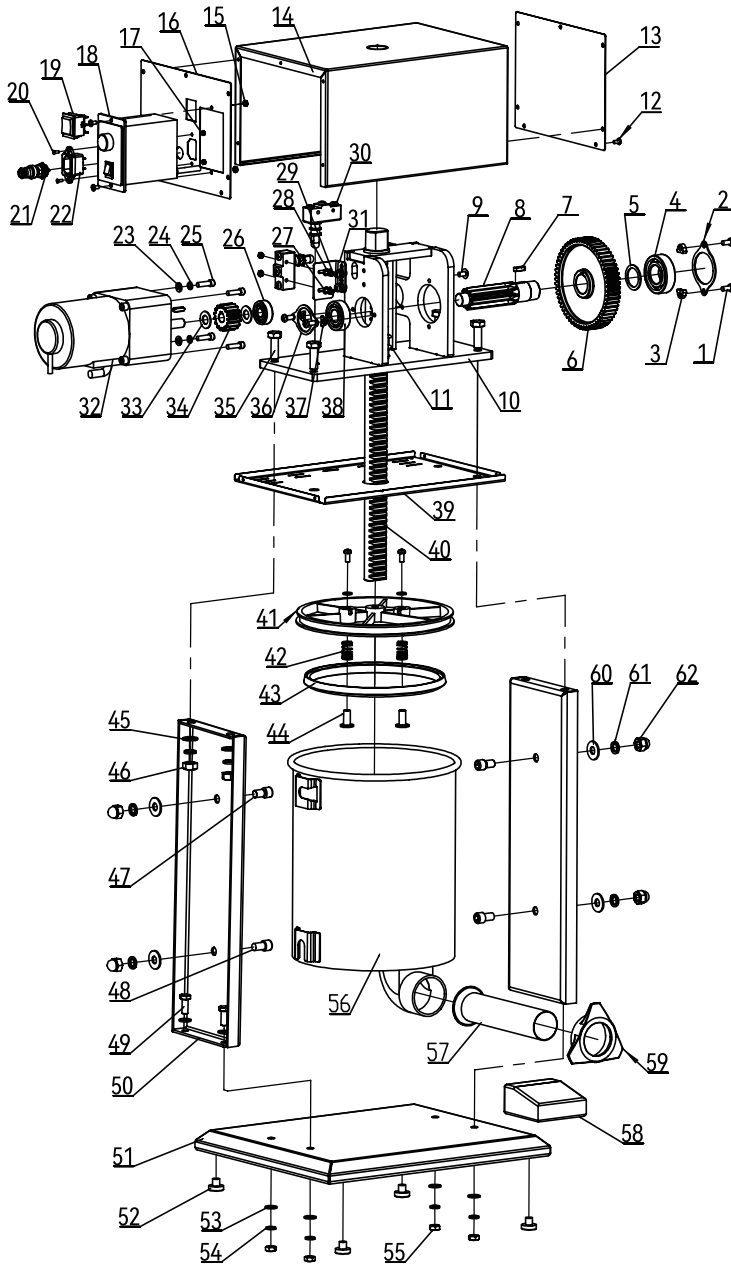

## ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION

1. Choose a workbench with a suitable height and make sure you have enough room for operation.
2. Please make sure the foot switch is plugged into the machine.
3. Assemble the stuffing tube. Four sizes of stuffing tubes have been provided with the unit (Diameters are 15mm, 21mm, 30mm and 37mm). Choose an appropriate tube and carefully insert it into the fixed collar, slowly tighten it onto the barrel, press down on the packing tube, and make sure it has been stuck and locked.

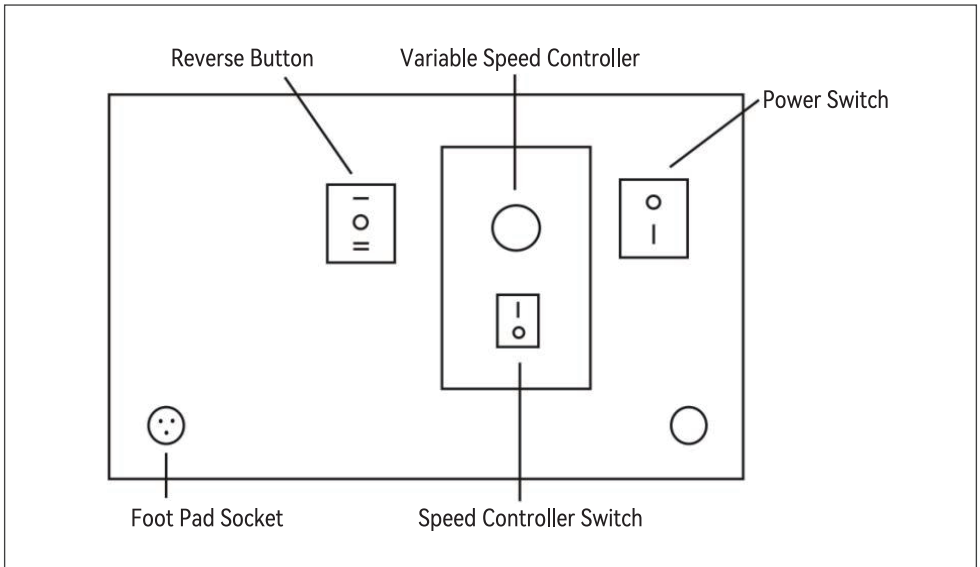

## OPERATION

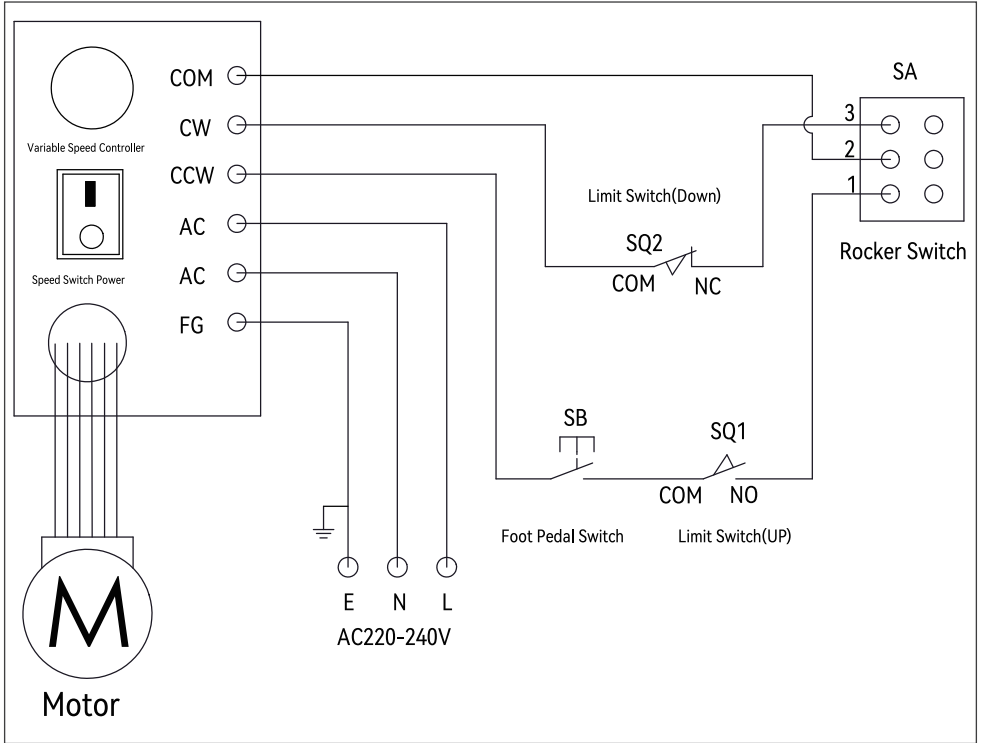
1. Place the pedal in a dry position.
2. Switch ON the power supply, and then set the on-off switch (red) to ON.
3. Turn the REVERSE switch (black) to UP and let the piston move to the top.
4. Tilt the cylinder and place the meat into the cylinder.
5. Place the cylinder back on the frame.
6. Turn the REVERSE switch (black) to DOWN and push the lower side of the footpad. The piston will start to drop.
7. If the piston drops too fast or too slow, use the speed controller (knob) on the side of the electric box to adjust to the appropriate speed.
8. When filling the housing, remove the foot from the pad and the piston will stop.
9. When the piston moves down to the bottom of the cylinder, the device will stop automatically. Then turn the REVERSE switch (black) to UP to lift the piston to the top.
10. Repeat the process from 4 if necessary.



## REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE

1. Please unplug the power supply before cleaning.
2. Remove and clean all parts that come in contact with the sausage.
3. Wipe non-removable parts with a cloth to remove bacteria.
4. Lubricate moving parts and gears to extend product life.
5. Do not use corrosive or abrasive detergents for cleaning.
6. Store the machine in a dry, clean and secure place.
